Introduction

The first official meeting of the Provincial Council was spread out over three sessions in July, 2020. In the first session, each Council member shared their vocation story as a way to get to know one another and highlight the priority issue over the next three years: Vocations.

Agenda

Carl shared with the Council the proposed agenda for this meeting and for future meetings. The agenda will follow the outline of the strategic plan, Vision 2020-2026. This will allow the Provincial Council to keep the strategic plan present at every meeting.

Priors

The Council would like each community to meet before August 15, 2020, and nominate a qualified member to be Prior, which is the ministry of spiritual and communal leadership. The Prior's responsibilities are:

- a. He calls the community to regular dialogue for the clarification of values and expectations of the common life at least once a month (normally).
- b. He challenges the community by his example and counsel to live the common life of fraternity and the community.
- c. He calls the community and individual members to accountability through the authority given to him by the community.
- d. He shows concern for the common life and the good of the individual members through sensitivity for the social and physical well-being of the members.
- e. The Prior shall name a Vicar in his absence.
- f. The Prior, after conferring with the members of the community, shall recommend the Provincial the appointment of the local bursar.

(S-53 of the Provincial Statutes)

The Provincial Council would like to remind incumbent Priors to invite all the Members of their communities to participate in the process, including individual brothers who are affiliated, but not living in the community. This also includes other brothers who live in houses that form the larger community.

Peru – Prelature of Sicuani

The Prelature of Sicuani sent a proposal through the Mission Office to fund ventilators for Covid-19 patients in Sicuani and the surrounding region. Joseph O'Brien was in agreement. Carl put the motion forward to send \$25,000 from the Mission Office to the Prelature of Sicuani. Daryl seconded. All agreed, the proposal passed unanimously.

Vocations

The Provincial Council continued their discussion on vocations from the Transitional Council Meeting that took place on June 30, 2020. David McEvoy will supervise the vocation effort, with Daryl Moresco, Paul Henson, and Gregory Houck assisting in their local regions. Two men in formation, Roberto Mejia and Roberto Reyes will also be a part of a new vocation commission to help create fresh ideas. The commission will also include members from our other regions: Mario Loya in Mexico, Luis Jesus Paz Acosta in El Salvador, and Jorge Jose Villegas in Peru. The Council hopes that with more men involved and an evaluation of the current program with many changes ahead will allow for our province to grow in the United States and Canada. The efforts in Peru, Mexico, and El Salvador are going well as each of the pre-novitiate programs have multiple candidates.

Formation - Novitiate

Jerry Payea sent in a six-month report on the four men currently in the Novitiate in Lurin, Peru. They include Tereso de Jesús Benitez Lopez, Jairo Augusto Hernandez Jimenez, Wilmer Ulises Ascencio Piche and Daniel Edgardo Juarez Colocho. Jerry reported on the dimensions of the common life, fraternal life, and prayer life. Ministry is on hold due to the Coronavirus. All these men are part of our program in El Salvador, so the simple profession is scheduled for the end of December in San Salvador, rather than in Peru.

Formation – Interns

David McEvoy will be working with the 12 men on Internship. During the next six-months he will be checking in with them using the Lifesize Video Conferencing Program. The Interns will not be attending in-person the Carmelite Studies Program at Whitefriars Hall in Washington, DC from August 12-16 to allow for social distancing in the house, especially in the chapel, dining room, and rec room. All the conferences will be livestreamed so that they can participate in the program.

Formation – El Salvador

Alfredo Guillen submitted a report on all the men in formation in El Salvador. There are eight solemnly professed Carmelites in El Salvador. Two men are preparing for diaconate, while another is preparing for solemn vows. There are many men in simple vows both in El Salvador and on internship in the United States. There will be ten pre-novices when the program begins again on August 9, 2020.

Formation – On-Going

A new program for those men leaving initial formation is the Elijah / Elisha Transition Program. In order to support our men finishing studies and leaving initial formation for full-time ministry, this program helps navigate the challenges of balancing prayer, community, and ministry, by providing a mentor for each Carmelite for their first two years of ministry. Quinn Conners and Daryl Moresco received feedback from participants in two video conferences on June 24, 2020. Better expectations for individual sessions need to be made clearer and the role of mentor needs to be clarified. There is a need for a director to organize and oversee this program. The hope of this program is for a better transition for those members leaving initial formation.

Ministry

The Council took some time to discuss issues in our parishes, at our schools, in the retreat houses, and the varied ministries that are performed by men of the province. Obviously, Covid-19 has affected every aspect of life so all of our ministries are responding to the challenges as they enter the unpredictability of the future.

Sponsorship

Thomas Batsis sent the Council a document on Sponsorship. Thomas highlighted two possible positions regarding this area, Carmelite Secondary Schools Coordinator and Carmelite Sponsorship Director. Thomas also encouraged the Council to budget Carmelite Tuition Grants especially during this time of Covid-19. The Council would like to investigate more the possibility of starting this program initially, looking for someone to serve as the Carmelite Secondary Schools Coordinator. Moving forward, Thomas also submitted job descriptions for these positions. The Council will continue discussing the best way to re-ignite this program that was begun by Joseph Atcher in 2010, but put on hold after he was elected to the Council and named Provincial Treasurer.

Strategic Plan

The Council reviewed the Strategic Plan and also discussed the idea of forming Council goals for the next three years. These goals will be based on areas/elements that the Council would like to highlight and stress as more important over the next three years.

Carmelite Chair in Spirituality – CUA

Daryl Moresco described the importance of the Center for Carmelite Spirituality at CUA. Stephen Payne, OCD, is the Director and will meet with Carl Markelz and David McEvoy when they hope to travel to Washington, DC during the second weekend of September for the solemn profession of Neil Conlisk on September 12, 2020.

Carmelite Media

Gregory Houck has met on several occasions with Ken Pino and Jorge Mora from Carmelite Media. Gregory will be a part-time consultant to Carmelite Media and Vocations as he finishes his program in Spirituality at Loyola University. Our efforts in communications and marketing will also coincide with our renewed efforts in Vocation Discernment. Carmelite Media will play a more important role with our social media platforms and moving us into more 21st century technology.

Carmelite Institute

The Institute was discussed and more coordination between our two provinces in North America and the OCD provinces is necessary for this effort to be successful in the evangelization projects of sharing our charism and spirituality with the world. Carmelite Media will also play a role in marketing the Carmelite Institute.

Society of the Little Flower

The Council discussed the importance of the **Society of the Little Flower**. Carl also shared with the Council that we also have the **League of the Miraculous Infant Jesus of Prague**, along with our efforts in El Salvador through the **Association of Our Lady of Mount Carmel**. These organizations all have “members” (donors) and they need to be included in our daily prayer as we do for “the members of the Society of the Little Flower and their intentions.” The Council will gather more information about these fundraising activities of our province and prepare some additional petitions for our community Masses, along with morning and evening prayer intercessions. The Council would like to thank Robert Colaresi for his 28 years shepherding these ministries, and Thomas Schrader for accepting the Directorship and leading these organizations and the important fundraising endeavors of the province.

Carmelite Missions

The Carmelite Missions was also highlighted as part of our promotion of Carmelite Spirituality. Special thanks to Joseph O’Brien for his hard work in this area. He continues to do what he can during the Covid-19 pandemic to raise funds for projects in the missions, especially through the monthly newsletter.

Justice, Peace, Integrity of Creation (JPIC) Grants

The Council approved two grants that were left over from the past Provincial Council and were in need of more verification:

The Province in the Philippines requested funds for their relief efforts for many families suffering from the impact of Covid-19. JPIC Commission approved \$13,500 and asked the Carmelite Mission Office to support this cause at the same level, \$13,500. As a result, from both the JPIC funds and Mission funds, **\$27,000 would be sent to the Province in the Philippines**. Rolf Nepi Willemsen made the motion, while Daryl Moresco seconded the motion. The Council voted unanimously in favor of the proposal.

A JPIC Emergency Funding Request was made by Sr. Flor Pauline Duran in the Philippines for their Convent living expenses of the Carmelite Sisters of Our Lady. The JPIC Commission approved this **\$25,000 request**. Rolf Nepi Willemsen made the motion, while Luis Jesus Paz Acosta seconded. The Council voted unanimously in favor of the proposal.

Boards and Commissions

The Council reviewed and made appointments to the many Boards and Commissions that serve the Province. Appendix A of these minutes lists the members of the Boards and Commissions. We want to thank the many men who will be going off these Boards and Commissions, and thank the new and returning members for serving during this three-year term.

Future Meetings

The Council decided to meet once a month via Lifesize for the next five months as we adhere to the recommendations of limiting travel especially to some regions of our province where Covid-19 may be spreading more rapidly. We decided to avoid conflicts in our own schedules by meeting on the following Saturdays:

August 22, 2020

Hopefully by January 2021, we will be able to travel more safely throughout the regions of the province.

July 22, 2020

Finances

Brian Gawel, Director of Finance, and Joseph Atcher, provided an update to the Council on the financial condition of the Province as of June 30, 2020, discussing in specifics the following:

The preliminary draft of the June 30, 2020, financial statements for the Provincial Office were reviewed. Brian walked through the balance sheet at June 30, 2020, and the statement of activities for the year ended June 30, 2020. The statement of activities indicates a deficit for the fiscal year of approximately \$2.3 million. Brian explained to the Council that unless the Investment portfolio incurs a positive return for the year, it is very difficult for the province to have a surplus as the province's revenues are not, in general, able to cover the annual expenses of the province. In terms of cash flow, Brian reported to the Council that he was able to manage such during the year so as not to have the Operating Fund need to draw down on the appropriated spending policy during the year.

During the fiscal year, the province repaid all outstanding bank debt with JP Morgan totaling \$783,000. Brian reviewed the various loans and receivables that the province has and provided an update on each balance. The total of such is approximately \$2.1 million.

The province's Investment portfolio and the Retirement Trust portfolio were reviewed. Brian advised the Council that aside from the significant market decline that occurred in March 2020, both portfolios have rebounded nicely. The Council was reminded that the Retirement Trust distributes over \$600,000 per quarter for benefit payments to retired Carmelites, and that unlike the province's Investment portfolio, significant market declines have a longer effect on the Trust assets due to the consistent distributions from the Trust.

Brian has been working with the outside auditors as it relates to the Fiscal 2020 financial statement audit. The auditors have completed their planning phase of the engagement and will commence final fieldwork in September.

St. Cecilia Parish / Carmelite Housing, Englewood, NJ

Joseph Atcher and Ryan Anderson, Director of Provincial Properties, updated the Council on the feasibility study for housing options at St. Cecilia Parish in Englewood, NJ. Joseph went through the options presented to all the men in NJ in April 2019. The project has continued with much work behind the scenes, including the civil engineering drawings, but it has been stalled with a moratorium on construction in NJ during the pandemic. The Council decided to continue gathering more information on the options, but did think there was some validity to moving the parish offices to the convent building, so the current priory would be only a Carmelite residence. Carl will meet with Herman and the new Prior regarding a possible way forward. No final decisions have been made regarding this project.

Community Discussions/Leadership Discernment Responses

The Council discussed the document that the Chapter Preparatory Commission sent to all members after communities met in April before the elections. Daryl shared that the Chapter Preparatory Commission will meet and discern how they will use this document at the Chapter in 2021. In the meantime, Nepi gave a summary of the document, stating that we should focus on three main ideas:

1) Expectations of the New Leadership Team; 2) Issues that Impact Community Life and 3) Ideas that Effect the Entire Province. The Council and Preparatory Commission will continue to reflect on the impact of this document.

List of Carmelites who have Committed Sexual Abuse

The Council reflected on our current situation regarding publishing a list of Carmelites who committed sexual abuse since 1950. Carl stated that most of the work has been completed, and now we need our lawyer, Jim Geoly, to instruct us on the best way to publish and distribute the list based on how other religious communities have done this. Carl is in the process of setting up this important meeting and will report back to the Council at our next meeting.

Communication with St. Elias Province

Carl has had a few phone conversations with Mario Esposito, Provincial of the St. Elias Province (SEL). They discussed the issues that our provinces share including the Carmelite Institute and Formation. The tentative date for the beginning the Novitiate (Reception Ceremony) next year will be June 13, 2021.

Racial Justice

The council reviewed a list of characteristics of a white supremacy culture that effects organizations. Some of these characteristics include; perfectionism, defensiveness, paternalism, power hoarding, individualism, and the right to comfort. The council will continue to be aware of this issue and not only how it affects our society, but how racism and discrimination has affected members of the province.

The Five Dysfunctions of a Team

Carl shared part of the book by Patrick Lencioni called, *The Five Dysfunctions of a Team*. The five dysfunctions include an absence of trust, fear of conflict, lack of commitment, avoidance of accountability, and an inattention to results. Looked at positively, a cohesive team trusts one another, engage in unfiltered conflict, commits to decisions and plans of action, hold one another accountable, and focuses on collective results. The council will use this book to help them function positively as a team so as to serve the province to the best of their abilities.
